Just as you wouldn't expect a plumber to be able to fix your teeth, other living organisms have behaviors (skills) and physical features (tools) that help them succeed in their habitat (workplace).



2nd Grade Standards Met:

"Biodiversity and Humans," There are many different kinds of living things in any area...which exist in different places on land and in water. Two main determinants for the distribution of life on earth: Non-living elements and living factors. Conditions change over time, especially where there is human activity. Those changes can favor one kind of living thing over another. Human activity, increasingly, plays a major role the changes we are seeing around the world.
